2 were: Diane Perez, 32; Roosevelt Howard, 8;  
3 Chris Vincent, zero votes.

4 In the envelope I placed the used  
5 and unused ballots and officer sign-in sheet.  
6 Let me know if you need anything else.

7 Regards, Deputy Chief Jose Rivera, East  
8 Chicago Police Department."

9 We just need to read this into the  
10 record and there is no action that needs to be taken.  
11 Olga will file this in the permanent records for the  
12 Board of Directors.

13 Now we have the Building Department  
14 here, notice of emergency order to demolish an unsafe  
15 building. Would you like to speak on this?

16 MR. PORTALATIN: James Portalatin. This  
17 is just a notice for emergency demolition of 508 East  
18 150th Street, just for the garage. The roof had  
19 collapsed so the structure was unsafe, so we had to  
20 demolish.

21 MR. REED: So we don't need to take  
22 action on this, Mr. Morrisroe?

23 MR. MORRISROE: No, we simply accept  
24 this. You are not asking -- do you want the Board to  
25 approve this?

MR. PORTALATIN: No, just a notice.

MR. MORRISROE: Just notice to the Board.

MR. REED: Thank you for the information.  
There is no audience here for participation at this  
time.

front of us, may we have a motion to adjourn?
